SUBOXONE EMERGENCY SUPPLY - CORRECTION

The previous newsletter that was sent out on May 14, 2019 stated that “the State of Wyoming will now allow one six (6) day emergency supply per month for Suboxone Films or buprenorphine/naloxone tablets when a prior authorization is required”. This statement was made in error. The State of Wyoming will only allow a six (6) day emergency fill at the initiation of therapy with Suboxone Films or buprenorphine/naloxone tablets. Once a claim for Suboxone Films or buprenorphine/naloxone tablets has been processed, emergency supplies will only process one year after a client’s last prescription fill of Suboxone Films or buprenorphine/naloxone tablets.

As stated in the previous newsletter, the six (6) day emergency supply, if it meets the conditions listed above, will process in the point-of-sale system by using a PA Type Code of “2” and a PA # of “8”.
