Effective February 17, 2016, all Syrspend SF oral vehicle products will be non-preferred. Please use the preferred oral vehicles for compounding. ## **DUPLICATE ANTIDEPRESSANT POLICY UPDATES**

Effective February 10, 2016, mirtazapine and bupropion will now be covered in combination with SNRIs (venlafaxine ER capsules, duloxetine, desvenlafaxine, Fetzima and Pristiq). Please note that all step therapy requirements and prior authorization requirements still apply for non-preferred SNRIs. Previously, Wyoming Medicaid only allowed duplicate antidepressant therapy of mirtazapine and bupropion with SSRIs. ## **ADAP AND TB CLAIMS**

Effective January 1, 2016 claims for the Aids Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) and the Tuberculosis (TB) program **WILL NO LONGER BE PROCESSED** through Goold Health Systems' Point-of-Sale system.
