PREFERRED DRUG LIST (PDL) CHANGES (Effective 10/8/2020)

THERAPEUTIC CATEGORY	PREFERRED DRUG LIST CHANGES
Convulsions Oral Anticonvulsants	Fintepla has been added and will be non-preferred. See Additional Therapeutic Clinical Criteria chart for more information.
Infectious Disease Anti-retrovirals	Rukobia will be non-preferred and requires documentation of multi-drug resistance (defined as failure of two medications from different classes)
Insomnia Non-benzodiazepines	Davyigo will be non-preferred.

ADDITIONAL THERAPEUTIC CRITERIA CHART (ATCC) CHANGES (Effective 10/8/2020)

- Epidiolex requires a diagnosis of seizures associated with Lennox-Gastaut syndrome, Dravet syndrome, or tuberous sclerosis and be \geq 1 year of age.
- Fintepla requires a diagnosis of seizures associated with Dravet syndrome and be \geq 2 years of age.
- Kynmobi requires a diagnosis of acute intermittent “off” episodes in Parkinson’s disease.
- Oriahn requires a diagnosis of heavy menstrual bleeding due to uterine fibroids in premenopausal women. This will be limited to 24 months of treatment.
- Palforzia requires a diagnosis of peanut allergy on file. Requires therapy initiation in clients age 4-17.
- All anti-psychotic agents will now be limited to 100% of the FDA maximum dose including injectables.
- Tricyclic Antidepressants requires a prior authorization for clients concurrently taking cyclobenzaprine. Prior authorization will be required for clients < 6 years of age.

DOSE LIMITATION CHART **CHANGES (Effective 10/8/2020)**

- Aristada has been updated to allow 1 injection of 882mg per 28 days per package insert updates.
- Sumatriptan Nasal Spray adds the 5mg dose with a limit of 12 bottles per 34 days.

PROVIDER MANUAL UPDATE (Effective 10/1/2020)
