MISCELLANEOUS UPDATES

- Effective on June 12, 2019, Saphris will require a prior authorization for clients under the age of 10 years old.
- Effective on June 12, 2019, Fanapt will require a prior authorization for clients under the age of 18 years old.
- Bijuva will be limited to an indication of moderate to severe vasomotor symptoms due to menopause.
- Effective on June 12, 2019, Uloric will be considered a non-preferred agent and will require a 60 day trial and failure of allopurinol prior to approval.
- Effective June 26, 2019, generic albuterol HFA will be preferred along with the Proair HFA, Ventolin HFA, and Proventil HFA.
- Effective June 26, 2019, the generic Fluticasone-Salmeterol will be preferred over Advair Diskus.

NARCOTIC INITIAL FILL QUANTITY LIMIT

Effective on July 1, 2019 Wyoming Medicaid will limit an initial fill of any narcotic to a seven day supply if the client has not had a prescription for a narcotic within the previous forty-five days. These limitations do not apply to buprenorphine and buprenorphine/naloxone medications. Additionally, any client with a current medical diagnosis of cancer will be exempt from these limitations.
